# Frequently Asked Questions

#### Where is a parking fee required?

A parking fee is required for anyone parking in any Downtown Lot, Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., any Marina Lot, and any Waterfront Lot or the Vallejo Station Parking Garage 24/7/365.

#### Where can I park for free?

Free parking is available in the Downtown Lots Monday - Friday, 6 p.m. to 9 a.m., and all day Saturdays and Sundays. Parking is always free of charge in any of the time-limited lots, or on the street, however posted time limits must be adhered to.

#### **How are Parking Fees Used?**

Parking fees are part of the Parking Enterprise Fund, wherein all revenue and expenses are tracked separately from the City's General Fund, and cover the cost of staffing, overhead, lighting, utilities, landscaping, janitorial, grounds, pavement, signage, infrastructure, maintenance, security, technology, enforcement, and more.

#### Can I park overnight and/or for multiple days?

Parking durations are limited to five consecutive days (120 hours). Overnight parking is permitted in the Downtown and Waterfront lots. The garage and lots are accessible 24/7/365.

#### Do I have to pay on the weekends and holidays?

Payment is required 24/7/365 in the Waterfront areas. Parking is free in the Downtown lots weekdays, 6 p.m. to 9 a.m. and all day Saturdays and Sundays.

#### Do I need to display my receipt?

No. Parking fees are electronically tied to your license plate number once you've paid.

#### I have a disabled placard, do I have to pay?

All vehicles parking in paid lots/structures must pay to park. Valid disabled placard holders may park for unlimited periods in any time-limited location at no cost.

#### Can I pay cash for parking?

Only the kiosk in the Ferry Building accepts cash; exact payment is required, change is not given.

#### Does the City of Vallejo offer refunds?

Only in the case of a duplicate transaction.

#### Can I park an oversized vehicle or RV?

Vehicles over 6,000 pounds, longer than 21 feet, house or truck trailers, or RVs, are not permitted to park in Park Vallejo parking lots.

#### Are there electric vehicle chargers?

There is a three-hour electric vehicle charger between City Hall and the JFK Library. Vehicle chargers will be added to the Vallejo Station Parking Garage and are estimated to be available to parkers by June, 2020.

#### My plans changed and I need to park for longer than I originally paid for, can I add more time?

Yes. Download the Parkmobile smartphone app to pay on-the-go, and start and/or extend parking sessions remotely. Be sure to enable in-app notifications.

#### Is there on-site security?

Yes. First Security Services is on duty 24/7/365, and is available to walk parkers to their vehicles by request. Their dispatch can be reached at (877) 900-1110.

#### Is there parking enforcement?

Yes. SP+ can be contacted at (707) 653-0938.

#### Where can I lock my bike?

Solano Transportation Authority (SolTrans) has bike lockers available; please contact them at (707) 648-4666 for more information.

#### Where can I report a non-emergency maintenance or kiosk issue?

Please contact the Parking Division at (707) 648-5407 or parkvallejo@cityofvallejo.net, or open a SeeClickFix service request online at seeclickfix.com/vallejo.

#### Do you offer discounts for residents?

Downtown monthly parking fees are discounted for residents who provide proof of identification and Downtown residency for parking in Downtown Lots. Waterfront parking fees are not discounted. Applications and more information is available at

#### Marina/Boat Launch parking fees

**Daily:** \$5.00 per day (day use only) **Monthly:** \$20.00 per calendar month

Monthly parking fees are not prorated.

#### **Payment Options**

You will need your license plate number for all transaction methods.

**Kiosk:** Pay hourly, daily, and monthly fees in the parking lots, parking garage and Ferry Building. **Online:** Pay monthly fees at parkvallejo.net.

**Smartphone:** Pay hourly and daily fees via the Parkmobile smartphone app.
